## **Discussion Requirements**

## For Students:

- 1) Post questions or answers to the discussions forum through vln.ucourses.com
  - Do not let anyone else log in with your username
  - Do practice respectful behavior online
  - Remember to post the actual question in addition to quoting the page and number from the workbook
  - Do not post actual answers online, rather guide your classmates to the right answer
- 2) Post a minimum of 10 questions/answers over the course of the term:
  - This number will likely increase in 3<sup>rd</sup> term
  - You will post a minimum of 2 questions in December, 4 questions in January and 4 questions in February. Do not post your questions on the same day. Each date will count towards ONE post.
- 3) Online participation marks are as follows:

## For Moderators:

- 2) If a discussion question posted is not answered within 2 days, do go ahead and answer it if you can
- 3) Do keep track of your hours (specifically, the exact dates and times you were providing moderator support) on a spreadsheet in Excel
  - I will set up a schedule where you can reserve the times you'd like to moderate so I will always know who should be moderating on any given day
  - A maximum of 2 hours per day can be claimed. This requires constant refreshing of the page to ensure all posts are seen.
  - A minimum of 2 hours a week must be "worked".
  - If your record-keeping has inconsistencies, you will be booted off the moderator team, and no service points will be awarded
